The National Institute of Advanced Studies proposes to expand its policy research devoted to exploring and finding solutions to some of India's huge, persistent and vexing energy problems. We are looking for individual/s with a recent doctorate in any of the relevant disciplines to work on environmental and social consequences of energy use, including climate change.

India has the dual problem that while providing clean, reliable and affordable energy services for continued economic growth to those with access, it has to provide similar services to those currently unserved. In order to be sustainable, the production of energy has to pay increasing attention to adverse social and environmental impacts. To maintain reliability, the security of supplies has to be ensured. Trade-offs between different constraints seem inevitable.

NIAS is a private, not-for-profit, Institute with the twin missions of conducting inter-disciplinary research on problems relating to the development of the country, particularly those requiring immediate study and resolution; and of imparting higher knowledge to professionals to broaden their academic and cultural perspectives. It provides a working environment conducive for scholarship and salaries competitive with other publicly funded premier Indian research institutions.

For a person with a fresh doctorate, the position is initially for two years and can be converted to an Assistant Professorship. For individuals with two-year post-doctoral experience, the appointment would be at the Assistant Professor level. 1. BIOSYSTEMATICS OF SPECIES COMPLEX : A 10-day workshop will be held at the CEMDE in the last week of December 2011. The research problem submitted by the applicant will be an important criterion for shortlisting.
