### Invitation for Innovative Research Proposals – 33rd Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica – Maitri and Bharati (33-ISEA)

The National Centre for Antarctic and Ocean Research, an autonomous R&D Institution under the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India is the nodal agency responsible for the planning, co-ordination and implementation of Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica. The Thirty Third Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica (33-ISEA) – Maitri and Bharati will be launched in November 2013. The summer team (shorter duration) component of 33-ISEA shall return to India in March 2014 whereas the winter team (longer duration) of 33-ISEA would return to India in March 2015.

The 33-ISEA shall continue to have CLIMATE CHANGE as one of the key thrust area, with biotic responses to climate as the theme for this expedition. NCAOR welcomes innovative scientific proposals in different disciplines having linkages to climate change.
