NCAOR will provide the requisite financial support to the selected candidates towards their participation in the said expedition. However, it will be the responsibility of the candidates to obtain the necessary Visas/permissions from the countries of embarkation and disembarkation on their own. A scientific plan is mandatory for a successful nomination. Once nominated, candidates will have to submit a detailed science plan along with sample data request which may also form a basis for collaborative research programs between their host organization and NCAOR.
