The Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, is implementing the National Mission for Sustaining Himalayan Ecosystem (NMSHE) programme through national institutions which are nodal agencies for different Task Forces. WII has been identified as the nodal agency for the Task Force on Fauna and Micro Flora and will be implementing a 5-year project (2014–2015 to 2019–2020) 'Assessment and Monitoring of Climate Change Effects on Wildlife Species and Ecosystems for Developing Adaptation and Mitigation Strategies in the Indian Himalayan Region' under NMSHE.
