Fellows will be connected with faculty across Harvard and other academic institutions in the Boston area as relevant to each Fellow's area of research. SAI will organize seminars at Harvard for Fellows to discuss their research with the broader community at Harvard and beyond.



Stipend for the one year programme: \$36,000

ELIGIBILITY

Scholars who have completed their PhD within the last five years from an institution in India and are working in B4 Program Partner Institutions in Karnataka in one of the following disciplines: Systems and synthetic biology, neurosciences, genomics and bionformatics, plant biology, and soft robotics and biomedical engineering.
