ADMISSION TO THE PHD PROGRAM OF MANIPAL ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION

We invite post-graduates with UGC/ CSIR - NET - JRF / ICMR - JRF / DBT-JRF / JEST / INSPIRE Fellowship or having qualified other UGC recognized national or state level eligibility tests with a valid fellowship to apply to the PhD program in areas of medicine, pharmacy, life sciences, allied health sciences, regenerative medicine, dentistry, public health, engineering and management at Manipal Academy of Higher Education.

Additional Support from the Manipal Academy of Higher Education:

The Manipal Academy of Higher Education will support such candidates enrolled for the PhD program at Manipal Academy of Higher Education in the following ways:

1. The student will be paid a stipend of Rs. 14,000/- per month till he/she gets the fellowship from the granting agency.
2. Contingency grants of Rs. 1,50,000/- per year for three years will be given for research work of the student to cover equipment, consumables and publication costs.
3. Financial assistance to a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- for each student during the entire fellowship period, for presenting paper at the national /

international conference(s).

4. Candidates who have been selected under the above scheme are exempted from payment of course fee.
5. Candidates are exempted from the qualifying written test conducted by Manipal Academy of Higher Education and their selection would be by a panel of experts through interview.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

Master's degree or a professional degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

The Virtual National Oral Cancer Institute (VNOCI) funded by Department of Biotechnology, Government of India is inviting for suitable candidate for the following temporary positions.

(1) Project Assistant: Qualification: Postgraduate in science (preferably Biochemistry/Biotechnology/Organic Chemistry) with the practical experience of working in laboratory system. Freshers can also apply. Candidate is expected to work in a team of Ph.D. students, Post Doctoral Fellows and clinicians, and perform different experiment related to immunohistochemistry analysis, RNA isolation from patient sample, gene expression analysis, raising antibodies, synthesis of small molecule inhibitors, etc.

No. of positions: 2; **Salary:** Rs 14,000/month + 30% HRA.

(2) Project Technical Officer: Qualification: Graduate in science with 2–3 years of work experience in a laboratory system or postgraduate in any branch of science with minimum 6 months of experience in laboratory system. Special emphasis will be given for the work experience to manage the DBT/DST/CSIR/DAE sponsored project and other secretarial work. The technical officers will be involved in the financial management, recruitment of manpower, communication between the groups, organizing periodical meetings, time to time communication with DBT, etc.

No. of positions: 1; **Salary:** Rs 27,800/month.

(3) Project Technician-II: Qualification: 10th pass with five years relevant experience (alternatively, 12th pass will be treated as 2 years experience and B.Sc. degree shall be treated as 3 years experience). Preference will be given to the candidates who have experience in interactions with physician, cancer patient sample collection and processing for research purposes. Project Technician will be involved to collect patient sample from hospitals, processing of the tissue sample, tabulating histopathological report, etc.

No. of positions: 1; **Salary:** Rs 14,200/month.
