Position: Scientist Gr. IV (7) (in Director's Grade) for CSIR Centre for Mathematical Modelling and Computer Simulation (C-MMACS), Bangalore

CSIR, the premier agency established by the Government of India to undertake scientific and industrial research, is seeking to appoint to head the CSIR Centre for Mathematical Modelling and Computer Simulation (C-MMACS) at Bangalore. It has an annual budget of about Rs 100 lakhs and a manpower of around 20, of which 12 are scientists. The centre has developed outstanding expertise, capabilities, facilities for computer simulation and mathematical modelling for a wide class of natural, environmental and engineered systems.

The incumbent for the post should have the proven ability to establish and maintain rapport with the academia, to create an environment conducive to high performance, to motivate and nurture staff through inter-personal intellectual interaction and must show evidence of efficiency in operations, effective communication, etc.

Qualifications and experience

First class M.Sc./1st Class B.E. recognized or equivalent qualification with not less than 65% marks with 19 years of experience in the relevant area; or M.Tech./M.E. with 17 years of relevant experience; or Ph.D. (Science) with 16 years of relevant experience; or Ph.D. (Engg.) with 15 years of relevant experience.

The candidate should have experience in an R&D institution, university department, scientific agency engaged in multi-disciplinary, multi-institutional research projects with external funding and collaboration with other scientific departments and agencies, etc. in the area of specialization of the Centre.

Age: Not above 54 years as on 10 November 1999. (Relaxation in age limit, qualification and/or experience is permissible in case of exceptionally meritorious candidates).

The post carries the pay scale of Rs 18,400-500-22,400 plus allowances as admissible to Council employees. Consultancy is permitted without any monetary ceiling on the annual consultancy remuneration.

Residential accommodation at Bangalore may be provided, if available, as per rules on payment of prescribed licence fee.

Interested candidates may apply on the prescribed application form obtainable free of cost from the Joint Secretary (Admn.), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, Anusandhan Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi 110 001, by sending a self-addressed envelope superscribing the name of the post applied for, affixing postal stamp worth Rs 3/- (Rupees three only).

Completed application form along with copies of certificates/testimonials and application fee for Rs 25/- (Rupees Twenty five only) in the form of crossed IPOs, drawn in favour of Joint Secretary (Admn.), CSIR, New Delhi 110 001 should reach by **10 November 1999**. Candidates belonging to SC/ST categories and departmental candidates of CSIR are exempt from application fee.

If the number of applications received for the post is large, the Screening Committee may adopt higher criteria for shortlisting candidates to be called for interview. The decision of the Council in this behalf will be final.

Candidates already in service should apply through proper channel.

Candidates invited for interview will be paid TA as per CSIR rules.

Canvassing in any form and/or bringing in any influence, political or otherwise, will be treated as disqualification for the post.
