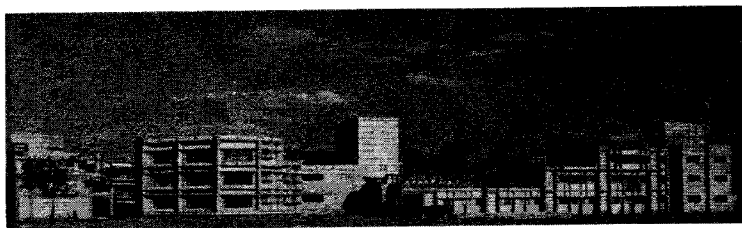


NCBS Symposium on Cell and Developmental Biology 9th-12th January 2001
