RRL, Bhopal has a total staff strength of around 180, of which one third are scientists. The annual budget is around Rs 600 lakhs.

Qualifications: M.E./M.Tech./M.S. with 14 years of experience or Ph.D. (Science) with 13 years of experience or Ph.D. (Engg.) with 12 years of experience in the relevant S&T discipline/field of the Institute.

Responsibilities: The Director as the Chief Executive of the Institute would be responsible among others for developing and managing an perspective plan for the Institute; providing scientific leadership to the diverse R&D groups; management of day to day operations including human resources management; promoting inter-laboratory and inter-agency R&D programmes and missions; negotiating and acquiring R&D grants/contracts; and building linkages with stake-holders and users.

Appointment: is on contract for a period of 6 years or up to superannuation at the age of 60 years whichever is earlier in the pay scale of Rs 18400–500–22400 plus allowances as admissible. The facility to share the monies realized from external contract R&D consultancy and rendering of S&T services is also available as per applicable rules.
