POSTDOCTORAL FELLOW POSITIONS

Two postdoctoral positions are available in the group of Prof. Jayant B. Udgaonkar at NCBS.

1. One position is supported by a DST-funded Swarnajayanti Fellowship grant and is for a collaborative project with Prof. G. Krishnamoorthy, Department of Chemical Sciences, TIFR, Mumbai. The scientist selected for this position will use laser based temperature-jump methods to study protein-folding in the nanosecond time domain.

Applications for this position are invited from candidates with a Ph.D. in physics/chemistry/engineering/physical biochemistry and with experience in laser spectroscopy and/or instrumentation. The selected person will be based at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research in Mumbai. Housing is likely to be provided.

2. One position is supported by a Wellcome Trust grant. The scientist selected for this position will develop and use rapid mixing methods in the study of protein folding and unfolding.

Applications for this position are invited from candidates with a Ph.D. in biochemistry/biology/chemistry/physics. The selected person will be based at the National Centre for Biological Sciences, Bangalore. Housing will be provided on or off campus.

For both positions, applicants should summarize recent research experience and include names and addresses of three persons who can be contacted for a critical evaluation of the applicant's research.
