For the Eastern Himalayas Program:

The candidate will work on natural resource management and biodiversity conservation issues. Must have an M Sc/Ph D in ecology/forestry or a related discipline with relevant experience and a good publication record. Candidates from the Eastern Himalayan region/north eastern India will be given preference. One position will require experience in GIS and ability to work at multiple spatial scales. The other position requires experience in natural resource management.

For the New Delhi Program:

Conservation education: The candidate will work on ATREE's conservation education program that seeks to develop a closer relationship between conservation and educational institutions. Must have an M Sc degree in ecology/environmental sciences or a related discipline. Essential pre-requisites are excellent communication/interpersonal skills and a demonstrated interest in making a career in the field of conservation education.

Natural Resource Management: The candidate should have experience in natural resource management/conservation of biodiversity with an M Sc/Ph D degree in ecology/forestry and a good publications record.

For all 4 positions candidates with experience in policy and/or community-outreach activities are also encouraged to apply.
