**NOTIFICATION**

It is proposed to prepare a panel in respect of Research Assistants/Junior Research Fellows/Project Assistants, etc. for the year 2004-05 so as to facilitate their posting depending on their suitability and receipt of new projects received during the year including appointment to the following sanctioned projects: (1) Studies on the uzifly sex pheromones to control its menace. Dr. G. Veeranna, Principal Investigator; (2) Utilization of economic potential of parthenium. Dr. M. V. Chandrakala, and Dr. J. Sukumar, Principal Investigators.

*Qualification:* 1st class or high 2nd class M.Sc., in Botany, Zoology, Sericulture, Chemistry, Bio Chemistry, Bio technology, Agriculture and other allied subjects with equivalent degrees. *Age limit:* Below 35 years. *Duration:* Maximum of three years or as applicable for the respective projects. *Consolidated emoluments:* Rs 5000 per month and onwards.

**Other conditions**

Place of work: KSSRDI, Thalaghattapura, Bangalore, and its substations.

*Type of Job:* Posts are purely temporary, restricted to period of the project and selected candidates are required to execute an undertaking as per the requirement of the project implementation. Eligible candidates would be considered for Ph.D. programme.

Eligible candidates may apply on plain paper giving their detailed bio-data along with copies of relevant documents and certificates in support of age, qualification, experience if any, etc. so as to reach The Director, Karnataka State Sericulture Research and Development Institute, Thalaghattapura, Kanakapura Road, Bangalore 560 062 within 15 days from the date of publication of the advertisement.

**PROPOSAL INVITED FOR NEW IDEA FUND**

A scheme of the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research

The Council of Scientific & Industrial Research has an ongoing scheme 'New Idea Fund' through which support is given to test and validate novel and highly creative ideas, even if they have a high probability of failure. Till now the scheme was open only to CSIR scientists for support. The experiment proved rewarding. Based on its initial experience, the scope of the scheme has now been widened to incorporate joint proposals between CSIR laboratories on one hand and scientific institutions or universities on the other.

**The Scheme**

CSIR invites joint proposals from CSIR laboratories in association with scientific institutions/universities under the 'New Idea Fund' – for support from CSIR. The joint proposals can be submitted for pursuing high risk, high innovation based proposals based on untried new idea.

The proposals of exploratory nature will be supported under the scheme for proving the feasibility of possibly far-reaching concepts.

**Who can apply**

Under the expanded scope, scientists from Indian R&D institutions and faculty members from universities can write proposals in partnership with a CSIR laboratory. Such joint proposals shall be forwarded through the collaborating CSIR laboratory.

**How to apply**

Five copies of the research proposal in the prescribed format should be submitted to DG, CSIR. The proposal can be submitted twice in a year in the months of September or March of every year. The proposal format can be obtained from Head, RDPD, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR), New Delhi.
