Professor M. Santappa Award – 2004

Nominations are invited for the Prof. M. Santappa award for the year 2004. The award of Rs 15,000/- was instituted in honour of Prof. M. Santappa, a distinguished physical chemist and a pioneer in Polymer Science who served as a Professor, in the University of Madras and later as Director of CLRI, Chennai. The award is given biennially by 'The Society for Polymer Science, India' to distinguished scientist for outstanding research contribution made in India during the 10 years preceding the year of award in the field of Polymer Science.

Nominations may be submitted by Vice-Chancellors of Universities; Deans of Science, Engineering and Technology faculties of Universities, Heads of Institutes and Heads of R&D organizations. Each such nomination shall be accompanied by a bio-data of the nominee along with a list of publications, highlights of the work carried out and a critical assessment (not more than 500 words) highlighting the importance and significance of research contribution made by the nominee during the past ten years.
