The course content to be covered is Photogeology, Remote Sensing, Digital Image Processing, Digital photogrammetry, Geographic Information System along with case studies and Block interpretation. Experienced and eminent scientists from the GSI/ISRO and other organizations will be the faculty for this course.

The Course is open to geologists from Central/State Government Organisations and Public Sector Undertakings and University/collage lecturers and research scholars in Geology stream, preferably less than 40 years age.
