INAE YOUNG ENGINEER AWARD 2005

Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE) invites nominations of young engineers from Academia, Government, R&D Laboratories, Industry and Defence Services having age not more than 35 years as on 1 January 2005 to recognize their outstanding achievements/contributions made to any branch of engineering.

The criteria for the award is excellence in design and technology transfer, innovative development and engineering research which should have been carried out totally in India. The sponsor must be a Fellow of INAE or Head of the Organisation/Institution where the nominee is working.

The award consists of a citation, a gold plated silver medallion and Rs.20,000/- in cash. In addition, the awardee may be considered by the Academy for recommendation for suitable research grant to further his/her chosen field of engineering, provided the proposal is considered worthy of such support.

The last date of receipt of nominations is **31 May 2005**.

INNOVATIVE STUDENT PROJECTS AWARD 2005

The Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE) invites nominations from Heads of Engineering Institutions at Doctoral, Master's and Bachelor levels for assessing their innovative potential and intrinsic merit on two best projects in each of major engineering disciplines as per following eligibility criteria.

- (i) B.E./B.Tech. projects should have been completed during the academic year 2004–2005
- (ii) M.E./M.Tech. and Ph.D. theses examined during the calendar year 2004.

Degree/Provisional Certificate should accompany the nomination proforma

The award money in each of the three categories will consist of a certificate, a medallion and Rs 10,000/-.

The last date of receipt of nominations is **15 July 2005**.

AICTE- INAE DISTINGUISHED VISITING PROFESSORSHIP SCHEME

The Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE) launched a Distinguished Visiting Professorship (DVP) Scheme jointly with AICTE during 1999. The Scheme envisages promotion of industry–institute interaction by facilitating the dissemination of knowledge through the expertise of experienced and knowledgeable persons from industry to integrate rich industrial experience with technical education. The selection of the Distinguished Visiting Professors is done by a high level Selection Committee consisting of experts from Academic Institutions, Industry and representatives from AICTE and CII.

The Scheme has received very enthusiastic response from industry and engineering institutions over the years.

INAE invites nominations from the Industry, DRDO/CSIR R&D Labs and Engineering Institutions/ Colleges.

The last date of receipt of nominations is **15 May 2005**.
