International Conference on 'Tectonics of the Indian Subcontinent' 3–6 March 2008, IIT Bombay

International Conference on '**Tectonics of the Indian Subcontinent**' (TOIS) will be organized by the Dept. of Earth Sciences, Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, at Mumbai between 3–6 March 2008, as a part of the Institute's Golden Jubilee Celebrations. The Conference will be held in collaboration with the International Association of Gondwana Research (IAGR), Japan and Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology (WIHG), Dehradun. The Conference is focused on the Tectonics of Indian Subcontinent which includes (i) Continental regions, (ii) Himalayan Mountain chain and (iii) Offshore regions of Indian Ocean. The Continental regions will cover Africa, Madagascar, Arabian Peninsula, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Australia and Antarctica. The conference will be attended by participants from several countries.

Pre-, Mid- and Post-Conference field trips, between 29 February–1 March 2008 around Dehradun across lesser Himalayas; on 5 March 2008 around Mumbai across Deccan Trap and between 8–9 March 2008, around Ambaji-Udaipur across the Aravallis are respectively proposed.
