The proposals will be subject to review both by the Indian and Japanese experts. The funds for the research projects will have to be arranged by the concerned scientists/researchers from the ongoing programme of their institute/organization or from other funding agencies.

INSA and Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) will only facilitate and support the visit of the scientists/researchers involved in the project from both the sides during the stipulated period. The focussed 2 years research proposal starting from the year 2008 in all areas of Natural Sciences including Engineering, Medicine & Agricultural Sciences should be submitted to Academy by **30 September 2007**.

Applications are invited from scientists having regular positions in recognized S&T institutions/universities for deputation abroad during the year 2008–2009 in all fields of Science including Engineering, Medical and Agriculture for short term visits (2–4 weeks for senior scientists) and long term visits (3–6 months for junior/younger scientists) under the Exchange Programme with overseas Academies/Organizations in Brazil, China, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Hungary, Kyrgyz Republic, South Korea, Nepal, The Netherlands, Philippines, Poland, Russia, Slovak Republic, Republic of Slovenia, Ukraine and UK.
