The Institute invites application from Indian nationals, possessing excellent academic background, commitment to quality teaching and potential for carrying out outstanding research.

Technology and Science knowledge background now form a very essential condition for building specialized legal profession in Technology Law and Intellectual Property Rights. In order to bridge the wide gap in the specialized legal professionals and human resource, the Rajiv Gandhi School of Intellectual Property Law has been established by the Institute and presently offers: (a) Three-Year Degree of Bachelor of Laws with specialization in Intellectual Property Rights, (b) Three-Semester Post Graduate Diploma in Intellectual Property Law and (c) Doctoral program in areas of law and related to intellectual property rights. The School is also engaged in various research and development activities towards creating the knowledge base in the given areas of study.

Name of the post : Professor – 01 Post.

The appointment is on contract for a period upto 3 years. The Professor may also be required to work as Head of Rajiv Gandhi School of Intellectual Property Law.

Scale of pay : Rs.18,400-500-22,400/- plus allowances as admissible to Central Government employees. (Pay is likely to be revised as per Sixth Central Pay Commission)

Qualifications : Ph.D. with first class or equivalent at the preceding degree in any of the following specialization and evidence of the ability to pursue independent high quality research.

Specialization : In the areas of Corporate Law, Family Law, Technical Law, International Law, Industrial Law, Laws Regulating Formation of Government Contracts, Laws for Intellectual Property Rights.

Experience : At least 10 years teaching / research of which 5 years should be at the level of Professor / Professional experience in High Court / Supreme Court as Advocate with proven publications and exposure to the International practices.

Academic reimbursements and other incentives :

1. Full funding for attending national conferences either for presenting a paper or chairing a session as per Institute guidelines.
2. Financial assistance up to Rs.1.00 lakh once in 3 years for attending International conferences for presenting a paper or chairing a session as per Institute guidelines. An additional amount of Rs. 50,000/- is being given from the SRIC fund to the faculty members who is the Principal Investigator of a Project amounting at least Rs. 15,00,000/- and has at least three Published Papers in the preceding three years.
3. Reimbursement of 75% of membership fee of one international professional society every year.
4. Contingent grant as per Institute rules.
5. Reimbursement of telephone charges up to Rs.750 per month.
6. Reimbursement of relocation charges to the faculty members at the time of their joining.

Accommodation will be provided on the campus subject to availability.

Interested candidates may apply enclosing (a) Curriculum Vitae, (b) List of Publications (with reprints of important publications), (c) Names and Addresses (with e-mail address and fax numbers) of at least three referees, (d) Any other details relevant to the candidature. Application form can be downloaded from the Institute web (www.iitkgp.ac.in).

The candidates applying from Government Organizations and Public Sector Undertaking should have their applications duly forwarded by competent authority.

Mere eligibility will not vest any right on any candidate for being called for interview. The decision of the Institute in all matters will be final. No correspondence will be entertained from the candidates in connection with the process of selection / interview. Canvassing in any manner would entail disqualification of the candidature. The Institute reserves the right to call only the requisite number of candidates for interview after shortlisting with reference to candidate's qualifications, suitability, experience, etc. However, the experience criteria may be relaxed for exceptionally meritorious candidates.
