The nominee should not be less than 50 years of age and with a standing of 25 years contributions in the concerned field of agricultural sciences while working in India. The awardee will be required to deliver a lecture based on his/her research contributions. 1	Scientist 'C' or higher post (Atmospheric Science and Astrophysics) Rs 10,000-325-15,200 or higher scale commensurate with post	(i) An excellent academic record with Master's degree in relevant field. The candidate must provide a list of publications in support of research and developmental experience.  (ii) Ph.D. degree with at least one year PDF research experience and good research contribution in the areas of observational Astrophysics and Atmospheric Sciences. The Scientist is expected to take responsibility while working in a group and should possess creativity and high potential for independent work.
2	Post Doctoral Fellow	(i) Candidates who have completed their Ph.D. degree or submitted their thesis in the research areas of ARIES. The applications should contain CV, list of publications, research proposal (2 pages) to be carried out at ARIES and two reference letters. The PDF positions is offered initially for one year, which can be extended up to maximum 5 year. A stipend of Rs 18,000 per month (Ph.D. degree awarded), Rs 16,000 per month (Ph.D. thesis submitted but degree awaited) and a contingency grant of Rs 20,000 per year will be provided. Apart from the proposed research work, the selected candidate should contribute to the developmental projects of ARIES in their respective areas.  (ii) Applications are considered throughout the year for PDF position.
