Emerging Directions in Global Education (EDGE) is an association of premium educational institutions with the objective of promoting Higher education and professional education in India.

EDGE has instituted short term Fellowships to encourage and foster research in the broad arena of higher education that includes internationalization, capacity building, innovative education, Public Private Partnerships. The fellowships are awarded initially for a period of six months extendable to a period of one year.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess at least a post graduate degree in any discipline with excellent communication and writing skills. It is desirable that the person has a wide interest in diverse areas of higher education and interested to undertake short term research studies related to higher education.

AGE: Not more than 40 years as on August 2008

JOB DESCRIPTION: Selected candidates will be expected to undertake short term research leading to research publication/s. The candidates may have to undertake travel to visit selected institutions across country to study best practices. They will be expected to also write for the Research Reports, News, and General sections of the EDGE Journal that is proposed to be launched soon. The candidates must be based in Bangalore and will work from the EDGE Secretariat but report to Dr. Anitha Kurup, Organizing Secretary, EDGE at NIAS, IISc Campus Bangalore.

Fellowship: Selected candidates will be offered a fellowship (as per the CSIR-JRF guidelines) in the range of Rs. 12,000 to Rs. 16,000 depending on qualification and experience. Applications along with a short proposal (not more than 500 words), CV and select publication, must be sent with in 23rd August 2008 to the address given below.
