DBT, Govt of India has recently launched a proposal under Human Resource Development Programme to impart training to the Postgraduates from various biological disciplines in identified areas of National relevance. Applications are invited from the interested candidates for an Advanced Diploma (Post M.Sc.) in Plant Tissue Culture and Micropropagation.

Eligibility : M.Sc. Degree of a recognised Indian University or Institutions in any of the following subjects with at least 55% marks in aggregate. (i) Botany; (ii) Life Sciences; (iii) Biotechnology; (iv) Forestry; (v) Environmental Botany, and (vi) Agriculture.

Duration : One year with intensive Lab-based curriculum and a Project/Dissertation.

Intake : 10 Seats

Stipend : Selected candidates are eligible for DBT studentship of Rs 5000 p.m. for one year.

Submission of Application & Selection procedure: Admission to the course is based on the merit aptitude determined through departmental test to be conducted by the Chairman and Course Coordinator, Department of Botany, AMU, Aligarh. The entrance test (questions of objective pattern with an emphasis on Plant Biotechnology, Molecular biology, Cytogenetics and phytodiversity conservation will be held on 4 June 2009 at 10–12 noon in the Department of Botany, AMU, Aligarh. Candidates are advised to reach Aligarh to appear at the test centre on given date and time. No separate intimation letters to appear in the test will be sent to the candidate.
