success stories already exist in this category.

Eventually when the programme runs full steam and matures, the industry must be able to proudly showcase a strong group of in-house researchers with leading-edge commercialized technologies. Such a thriving group will be able to bid for research funding from government agencies towards national missions. It will be possible over a period of time for

the venture to sustain itself with royalty and external research funding.

Sustenance and evaluation

The programme will require appropriate means of evaluation, grading and continued support with consolidation of accomplishments and formulation of fresh goals. Annual conferences hosted in a round-robin fashion by each of the centres

of excellence showcasing their accomplishments ought to be a good open platform for review and course correction.
